It is the coach's responsibility to check players'/team's availability ahead of time and make your request accordingly. Weber County is not responsible to make-up forfeited games. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding as we try to accommodate as many requests as possible.**

Indemnity Waiver: I agree to indemnify and hold Weber County, it's officers, officials, employees and agents harmless from any and all claims and to defend said county and pay for all costs incurred in the defense of claims against the county, it's officers, officials, and employees, and agents, which arise out of the activities of the applicant or any person participating as a member of the applicant's group.

Parent Code of Conduct (or Legal Guardian): Athletic participation is more than just exercise. It is a chance to build the character of young men and women. Weber County strives to have competition build: sportsmanship, leadership, teamwork, responsibility, dedication, and professionalism. All parents who participate in Weber County Recreation youth programs are expected to:

1. Refrain from coaching their child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the registered coaches for the team.
2. Respect the officials, scorekeepers and supervisors and their authority during games and will never question, discuss or confront officials in any way that is threatening, vulgar, or in any way unsportsmanlike.
3. Remember that youth athletes participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
4. Be a positive role model for their child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
5. Not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player or parent such as booing and taunting, refusing to shake hands, or using profane language or gestures.
6. Not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well-being of athletes.
7. Demand that their child treats other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect at all times regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
8. Not ridicule or yell at their child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a completion.
9. Abide by player participation rules and regulations as set forth in the Utah High School Activities Association Handbook ("UHSAAH") which is hereby incorporated by reference. The UHSAAH is available by visiting the Utah High School Activities Association website at uhsaa.org/uhsaa-handbook/.
Coaches shall be individually responsible for verifying each player's eligibility in accordance with the UHSAA eligibility standards and any eligibility rules established by the Weber County Parks & Recreation Department. Weber County Parks & Recreation reserves the right to review any and all documentation obtained by a coach pertaining to a player's eligibility including, but not limited to, a birth certificate, school identification card, or other appropriate form of eligibility documentation. The Weber County Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to suspend any team and/or coach from participating in any sports activities if that coach fails to abide by eligibility rules and requirements or refuses to provide proof of eligibility documents.
10. Any person(s) that continuously violate(s) the Code of Conduct at Weber County Facilities or any partnering facility including, but not limited to, South Ogden City and South Weber City facilities, may be suspended or banned from playing, coaching, or spectating at any or all of the facilities for a specific amount of time depending on the severity of violation(s).

Refund Policy: Refunds requested 15 calendar days or more before league play will result in a **\$100 (deposit)** penalty.
Refunds requested within 14 calendar days of play will result in a **100%** penalty (NO REFUND).
Full refunds will not be granted unless league is canceled by the Recreation department.

In the event that Weber County Recreation is not able to accommodate this team as part of the requested league, Weber County Recreation may make accommodations for the team with a neighboring recreation organization or will refund payment. Team coaches will be notified if this becomes necessary.
