**High Power Rifle Match Weapon Requirements Match Rules and Match Stages**

All rifles used for the match must meet the minimum requirements for use at the Weber County Sport Shooting Complex. Minimum requirements are centerfire rifle 16" minimum barrel length, caliber with a minimum muzzle velocity of 2,400 fps, have a minimum four power optic no aim point e-otech or other red dot type scopes. Rifle and scope must have been zeroed on paper before being used on the 300 yard range. (Rifles that have only been bore sighted are not allowed). All range safety rules will be strictly enforced during the match and eye and ear protection are mandatory.

Although a minimum four power scope is required for use of the range, it is highly recommended that match shooters have a 16 power or greater scope.

Match rules will be explained at each event and may change based on the match being held.

1. The match will be 5 Stages:
  - a. Stage 1, 100 yards, 6 shots
  - b. Stage 2, 200 yards, 6 shots
  - c. Stage 3, 300 yards, best group 10 shots
  - d. Stage 4, 100 yards, best group 10 shots
  - e. Stage 5, Balloons, 3 shots.
2. Each stage will have a time limit of three (3) minutes, except for the balloons, which will be 30 seconds each.
3. The targets and balloons must be engaged in sequence as described in the orientation prior to the match.
  - a. Anyone shooting the targets out of sequence will zero that stage.
  - b. The 10 cold shot may or may not be shot. No penalty for not shooting the 10 cold shot.
4. The targets will be scored on a point basis for the number of hits on point targets.
5. The cost for the match will be \$15.00.
6. The match will be for any shooter, regardless of expertise.
7. Each target will be scored and posted at the end of the match.
8. If your target is shot inadvertently by someone else, the best score for that target will be posted.
9. Bags of any type and bipods may be used during the match. If no bipod is used, when the rifle is picked up, the support must stay on the bench. **EXCEPT, no lead sleds or rigid support rests that contain the entire rifle may be used.**
10. If a KYL (know your limits) match is to be shot, it will be announced a month in advance.
